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ICAF GRAD CAPT FRANK J. SMITH (RET) HEADS NATIONAL CULTURAL HERITAGE TOURISM CENTER



Retired Navy Captain Frank J. Smith will serve as the chairman of the Board of Directors for the new National Cultural Heritage Tourism Center.

The National Cultural Heritage Tourism Center is a project of the Florida Black Chamber of Commerce, focused on bringing more African American culture into the tourism industry.

Currently based in Florida, the project hopes to solicit information from other communities across the nation about destinations of cultural significance to black tourists.

During Capt. Smith's naval career, he served on the USS John F. Kennedy, the USS Coral Sea and at the Pentagon. He also was commanding officer of the Navy Air Maintenance Training Group at Pensacola. He obtained his master's degree in national resource strategy from the Industrial College of the Armed Forces.
